## STIPULATION AND ORDER TO RESTRICT SCOPE OF PRACTICE

IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED by and between the parties hereto, the Investigative Committee of the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners (Board), composed of Charles N. Held, M.D., Theodore B. Berndt, M.D., and Valerie J. Clark, BSN, RHU, LUTCF, by and through Edward O. Cousineau, Deputy Executive Director for the Board and attorney for the Investigative Committee, and Conrad R. Murray, M.D., by and through his counsel of record, that based upon a criminal matter currently being prosecuted in the state of California related to alleged non-therapeutic prescribing of medications that allegedly resulted in the death of a patient and based upon the condition of bail in that criminal matter, Dr. Murray agrees that he is restricted from prescribing or administering, except as mentioned below, any anesthetic agent normally administered by an anesthesiologist, including but not limited to Propofol or any other heavy sedative medication used as anesthesia, in the course of his medical practice in the State of Nevada.

It is understood by the parties that Dr. Murray may still prescribe or administer any other medications, including but not limited to pain and anti-anxiety medications or local or topical anesthetics, in the course of his medical practice in the state of Nevada. And that Dr. Murray may, in concert with other physicians, participate in medical treatment which involves the use of

Propofol or any other heavy sedative medication used as anesthesia, as long as Dr. Murray does not personally prescribe or administer these medications.

Further, Dr. Murray has cooperated in the investigation regarding this Stipulation and agrees that the aforementioned restrictions on his medical practice in the state of Nevada shall not be modified, stayed or removed, until there is a final resolution of the criminal allegations in California or until the Board takes other action to modify the Order so as to properly reflect the terms of bail as they may be modified in California. Once the referenced criminal matters are resolved, or at any time prior thereto, Dr. Murray may petition the Investigative Committee in writing for removal or revision of this stipulation by showing that the bail requirements are no longer in effect or have been modified, stayed or removed.
