

10 **COMPLAINT**

11 The Investigative Committee of the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners ("Board"),
12 composed at the time of filing of Theodore B. Berndt, M.D., Chairman,
13 Valerie J. Clark, BSN, RHU, LUTCF, Member, and Michael J. Fischer, M.D., Member, by and
14 through Bradley O. Van Ry, Deputy General Counsel, having a reasonable basis to believe that
15 Maria Corazon Orozco Regalado, M.D., hereinafter referred to as "Respondent," has violated the
16 provisions of NRS Chapter 630, hereby issues its formal Complaint, stating the Investigative
17 Committee's charges and allegations, as follows:
18

19 1. Respondent, is currently licensed in active status (License No. 8966), and has been
20 so licensed since April 27, 1999 by the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners pursuant to the
21 provisions of Chapter 630 of the Nevada Revised Statutes.

22 2. On April 9, 2011, a person in North Las Vegas, Nevada died as a result of cosmetic
23 surgery performed by two persons not licensed to practice medicine in the state of Nevada. The
24 persons performing the surgery were Ruben Mattallana-Galvas and Carmen Torres-Sanchez. Both
25 Mr. Mattallana-Galvas and Ms. Torres-Sanchez plead guilty to involuntary manslaughter on
26 August 4, 2011 as a result of their actions causing the death of the patient.

27 3. Respondent had, on at least one occasion, received medical treatment from
28 Mr. Mattallana-Galvas. Additionally, Respondent had a previous filial, personal and/or separate

1 professional relationship with either Mr. Mattallana-Galvas and/or Ms. Torres-Sanchez. As a
2 result, Respondent knew, or should have known, that neither Mr. Mattallana-Galvas and/or Ms.
3 Torres-Sanchez were licensed physicians in the state of Nevada.

4 4. Unfortunately, Respondent never reported the unlicensed medical practices of both
5 of the foregoing to the medical board or any criminal authority at anytime.

6 **Count I**

7 5. All of the allegations in the above paragraphs are hereby incorporated as if fully set
8 forth herein.

9 6. Nevada Revised Statute Section 630.305(1)(e) provides that aiding, assisting,
10 employing or advising, directly or indirectly, any unlicensed person to engage in the practice of
11 medicine contrary to the provisions of this chapter or the regulations of the Board is grounds for
12 initiating discipline against a licensee.

13 7. By reason of the foregoing, Respondent is subject to discipline by the Nevada State
14 Board of Medical Examiners as provided in Section 630.352 of the Nevada Revised Statutes.

15 **Count II**

16 8. All of the allegations in the above paragraphs are hereby incorporated as if fully set
17 forth herein.

18 9. Nevada Revised Statute Section 630.3065(3) provides that the willful failure to
19 perform a statutory or other legal obligation imposed upon a licensed physician is grounds for
20 initiating discipline against a licensee.

21 10. By reason of the foregoing, Respondent is subject to discipline by the Nevada State
22 Board of Medical Examiners as provided in Section 630.352 of the Nevada Revised Statutes.

23 **Count III**

24 11. All of the allegations in the above paragraphs are hereby incorporated as if fully set
25 forth herein.

26 12. Nevada Revised Statute Section 630.3062(6) provides that the failure to report any
27 person the licensee knows, or has reason to know, is in violation of the provisions of this chapter

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1 or the regulations of the Board within 30 days after the date the licensee knows or has reason to
2 know of the violation is grounds for initiating discipline against a licensee.

3 13. By reason of the foregoing, Respondent is subject to discipline by the Nevada State
4 Board of Medical Examiners as provided in Section 630.352 of the Nevada Revised Statutes.

5 **WHEREFORE**, the Investigative Committee prays:

6 1. That the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners give Respondent notice of the
7 charges herein against her and give her notice that she may file an answer to the Complaint herein
8 as set forth in Section 630.339 of the Nevada Revised Statutes within twenty (20) days of service
9 of the Complaint.

10 2. That the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners set a time and place for a
11 formal hearing after holding an Early Case Conference pursuant to NRS §630.339(3);


12 3. That the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners determine what sanctions it
13 determines to impose if it determines there has been a violation or violations of the
14 Medical Practice Act (Nevada Revised Statutes Chapter 630) committed by Respondent; and

15 4. That the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners make, issue and serve on
16 Respondent its findings of facts, conclusions of law and order, in writing, that includes the
17 sanctions imposed; and

18 5. That the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners take such other and further
19 action as may be just and proper in these premises.

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
