11 **SETTLEMENT, WAIVER AND CONSENT AGREEMENT**

12 This Agreement is hereby entered into by and between the
13 Investigative Committee (IC) of the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners (the Board)
14 composed of Theodore B. Berndt, M.D., Chairman, Valerie J. Clark, BSN, RHU, LUTCF,
15 Member, and Michael J. Fischer, M.D., Member, in the above-captioned matter, by and through
16 Bradley O. Van Ry, Esq., Deputy General Counsel for the Board and counsel for the IC, and
17 Jocelyn Quebral Ivie, M.D. (Respondent), by and through her legal counsel
18 Robert McBride, Esq., as follows:

19 **WHEREAS**, on February 22, 2011, the Board's IC filed a formal Complaint in the above-
20 referenced matter charging Respondent with engaging in conduct that is grounds for discipline
21 pursuant to the Nevada's Medical Practice Act, i.e., Chapter 630 of the Nevada Revised Statutes
22 (NRS), to wit: a violation of NRS Section 630.301(4), NAC 630.040; and,

23 **WHEREAS**, Respondent has received a copy of the formal Complaint, reviewed it,
24 understands it, and has had ample opportunity to consult with her counsel,
25 Robert McBride, Esq., concerning the nature and significance of the formal Complaint, and
26 Respondent is fully aware concerning her rights and defenses to the formal Complaint as well as
27 the possible sanctions that may be imposed if the Board finds and concludes that she has violated
28 one or more provisions of the Medical Practice Act; and,

1 **WHEREAS**, Respondent understands and agrees that this Agreement is entered into by
2 and between herself and the Board's IC, and not with the Board, but that the IC will present this
3 Agreement to the Board for consideration in open session at a meeting duly noticed and scheduled,
4 and that the IC shall advocate approval of this Agreement by the Board, but that the Board has the
5 right to decide in its own discretion whether or not to approve this Agreement; and,

6 **WHEREAS**, Respondent understands and agrees that if the Board approves the terms,
7 covenants and conditions of this Agreement, then the terms, covenants and conditions enumerated
8 below shall be binding and enforceable upon her; and,

9 **WHEREAS**, Respondent understands and agrees that if the Board does not approve the
10 terms, covenants and conditions of this Agreement, then the terms, covenants and conditions
11 enumerated below shall not be binding and enforceable upon her except the provisions as to
12 disqualification of adjudicating panel members in paragraph number 8, and she will be provided
13 with an opportunity to defend herself against the charges against her as alleged in the formal
14 Complaint at a regularly scheduled hearing in accordance with all applicable laws; and,

15 **NOW THEREFORE**, in order to resolve this matter and all charges alleged by the
16 Board's IC in the above-captioned matter, Respondent and the IC hereby agree to the following
17 terms, covenants and conditions:

18 **1. Jurisdiction.** Respondent consents to the jurisdiction of the Board to hear and
19 adjudicate charges of violations of the Medical Practice Act (NRS 630), and to impose sanctions
20 as provided by the Act as a physician licensed to practice medicine in the
21 State of Nevada during the time of the incident involving Patient A.

22 **2. Representation by Counsel/ Knowing, Willing and Intelligent Agreement.**
23 Respondent is represented by Robert McBride, Esq. in this matter and has had ample
24 opportunity to review this agreement, the formal Complaint filed in this matter and related factual
25 basis with said legal counsel. Respondent further covenants and agrees that she enters into this
26 Agreement knowingly, willingly, and intelligently.

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1 **3. Waiver of Rights.** In connection with this Agreement, and the terms, covenants
2 and conditions contained herein, and the understanding that Respondent knowingly, willingly and
3 intelligently, waives all rights arising under or pursuant to the United States Constitution, the
4 Constitution of the state of Nevada, NRS Chapter 630, NRS Chapter 233B, and any other statutory
5 rights that may be available to her or that may apply to her in connection with the proceeding on
6 the formal Complaint filed herein, the defense of said formal Complaint and the adjudication of
7 the charges in said formal Complaint, and Respondent further agrees that the matter of the formal
8 Complaint herein may be settled and resolved in accordance with this Agreement without a
9 hearing or any further proceeding, and without the right to judicial review. In the event this
10 Agreement is not approved by the Board, this Agreement shall have no force and effect and shall
11 be *void ab initio*, and Respondent shall have all rights arising under or pursuant to the United
12 States Constitution, the Constitution of the state of Nevada, NRS Chapter 630, NRS Chapter
13 233B, and any other statutory rights that may be available to her or that may apply to her in
14 connection with the proceeding on the formal Complaint filed herein.

15 **4. Consent to Entry of Order.** Respondent is aware that the trier of fact, the Board,
16 may find a factual basis in support of the formal Complaint against Respondent. Accordingly, in
17 order to resolve the matter without incurring further costs and expense of providing a defense to
18 the formal Complaint or to any other further Amended Complaint; and in exchange for the waiver
19 of the Respondent's foregoing rights, Respondent has entered into this Agreement¹, and agrees:

20 a. The Board may find that Respondent has engaged in conduct that is grounds
21 for discipline pursuant to the Medical Practice Act, to wit: a violation of Nevada Revised Statute
22 Section 630.301(4) and NAC 630.040 by failing to use the reasonable care, skill, or knowledge as a
23 physician under the same or similar circumstances relating to the diagnosis, treatment and care of
24 Patient A; and,

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27 ¹ All admissions made by Respondent are solely for final disposition of this matter and any subsequent related
28 administrative proceedings or civil litigation involving the Board and Respondent. Therefore, said admissions by
Respondent are not intended or made for any other use, such as in the context of another state or federal government
regulatory agency proceeding, state or federal civil or criminal court proceeding, or any other state or federal court, or
any credentialing or privileges matter.

1 b. Pursuant to NRS §622.400, Respondent shall pay the sum of \$2,659.79, the
2 current amount of the costs incurred by the Board to investigate and prosecute this matter, along
3 with the costs to conclude the matter, if any. The costs shall be paid to the Nevada State Board of
4 Medical Examiners within thirty (30) days of the Board's acceptance and approval of this
5 Agreement; and,

6 c. Respondent shall attend and participate in six (6) hours of CME in fetal
7 distress and delivery in addition to the normal CME requirements for licensure. Respondent's
8 attendance and participation in the ordered CME shall be in person and accomplished within one
9 (1) year of the entry of this Agreement, and Respondent shall provide proof of attendance and
10 participation to the Board.

11 **5. Release From Liability.** In execution of this Agreement, the Respondent, for
12 herself, her executors, successors and assigns, hereby releases and forever discharges the state of
13 Nevada, the Board, the Nevada Attorney General, and each of their members, agents and
14 employees in their representative capacities, and in their individual capacities, from any and all
15 manner of actions, causes of action, suites, debts, judgments, executions, claims and demands
16 whatsoever, known and unknown, in law or equity, that Respondent ever had, now has, may have
17 or claim to have, against any or all of the persons or entities named in this paragraph arising out of
18 or by reason of this investigation, this settlement or its administration.

19 **6. Procedure of Adoption of Agreement.** The IC and counsel for the IC shall
20 recommend approval and adoption of the terms, covenants and conditions contained herein by the
21 Board in resolution of the formal Complaint pending herein against Respondent. In the course of
22 seeking Board approval, adoption and/or acceptance of this Agreement, counsel for the IC may
23 communicate directly with the Board staff and members of the panel of the Board who would
24 adjudicate this case if it were to go to hearing.

25 Respondent acknowledges that such contacts and communication may be made or
26 conducted ex parte, without notice or opportunity to be heard on her part or on the part of her
27 counsel until the public Board meeting where this Agreement is discussed, and that such contacts
28 and communications may include, but not be limited to, matters concerning this Agreement, the

1 formal Complaint, and any and all information of every nature whatsoever related to the formal
2 Complaint or the proceedings herein against Respondent. The IC and its counsel agree that
3 Respondent and/or her counsel, if any, may appear at the Board meeting where this Agreement is
4 discussed, and if requested, to respond to any questions that may be addressed to the IC or its
5 counsel.

6 **7. Effect of Acceptance of Agreement by Board.** In the event the Board approves,
7 accepts and adopts the terms, covenants and conditions set out in this Agreement, counsel for the
8 IC will cause to be entered herein the Board's Order accepting, adopting and approving this
9 Settlement, Waiver and Consent Agreement, ordering full compliance with the terms herein and
10 ordering that this case be closed.

11 **8. Effect of Rejection of Agreement by Board.** In the event the Board does not
12 approve, accept and adopt the terms covenants and conditions set out in this Agreement, this
13 Agreement shall be null, void, and of no further force and effect except as to the following
14 covenant and agreement regarding disqualification of adjudicating Board panel members.
15 Respondent agrees that, notwithstanding rejection of this Agreement by the Board, nothing
16 contained herein and nothing that occurs pursuant to efforts of the IC or its counsel to seek
17 acceptance and adoption of this Agreement by the Board shall disqualify any member of the
18 adjudicating panel of the Board from considering the charges against Respondent and participating
19 in the disciplinary proceeding in any role, including adjudication of the case. Respondent further
20 agrees that she shall not seek to disqualify any such member absent evidence of bad faith.

21 **9. Binding Effect.** Providing this Agreement is approved by the Board, Respondent
22 covenants and agrees that this Agreement is a binding and enforceable contract upon Respondent
23 and the Board's IC, which contract may be enforced in a court or tribunal having jurisdiction.

24 **10. Forum Selection Clause.** Respondent covenants and agrees that in the event either
25 party is required to seek enforcement of this Agreement in the district court, she consents to such
26 jurisdiction, and covenants and agrees that exclusive jurisdiction shall be in the Second Judicial
27 District Court of the state of Nevada in and for the county of Washoe.


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11. **Attorneys' Fees and Costs**. Respondent covenants and agrees that in the event an action is commenced in the district court to enforce any provision of this Agreement, the prevailing party shall be entitled to recover costs and reasonable attorneys' fees.


