



1 (Mr. Hoodbhoy) to impersonate a Nevada licensed physician and pose as a physician when not  
2 actively licensed to practice medicine by the Board. Dr. Jones also allowed Mr. Hoodbhoy to  
3 illegally prescribe, administer and dispense controlled substances and/or dangerous drugs. As  
4 such, Dr. Jones aided and abetted Mr. Hoodbhoy in the unlicensed practice of medicine since  
5 approximately January 2012.

6 The Board's preliminary investigation found that Mr. Hoodbhoy has illegally examined,  
7 diagnosed and treated hundreds of patients since approximately January 2012. The Board's  
8 preliminary investigation also revealed that Mr. Hoodbhoy's patients were treated with controlled  
9 substances and dangerous drugs, including but not limited to, testosterone, phentermine, B-12  
10 vitamins and HCG. Some of the treatments also required injections. All of this took place even  
11 though Mr. Hoodbhoy was not licensed as an authorized Nevada prescriber and/or dispenser of  
12 these substances by the Nevada State Board of Pharmacy (Board of Pharmacy).

13 Relatedly, Mr. Hoodbhoy also illegally used the authorized signature stamp of Dr. Jones,  
14 and therefore her federal DEA registration number, on multiple prescriptions. Mr. Hoodbhoy also  
15 personally, and illegally, signed as a prescriber of controlled substances and/or dangerous drugs on  
16 multiple prescriptions. Dr. Jones was rarely, if ever, present at the center; did not see the patients;  
17 did not authorize prescriptions for those patients; and did not properly supervise  
18 Mr. Hoodbhoy's practice of medicine.

19 Along those lines, the Board of Pharmacy's associated investigation led to the issuance of a  
20 "Notice to Pharmacists" (Notice) on April 10, 2013. In that Notice, the Board of Pharmacy  
21 instructed all pharmacies in the state of Nevada to "not fill any prescriptions with the prescription  
22 header "Las Vegas Health Center" signed by Carmen F. Jones, M.D. . . . ."

23 The Board's preliminary investigation also revealed that Dr. Jones is the Medical Director  
24 of at least one other health services office, Agape Health. Significantly, Dr. Jones admitted to  
25 Board investigative staff the following:

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1. Dr. Jones admitted to allowing unlicensed persons to practice medicine without a license at Las Vegas Health Center & Agape Health by failing to treat the patients herself and allowing staff to treat the patients.

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- 1 2. Dr. Jones admitted to allowing unlicensed persons to use her Board of Pharmacy signature  
2 stamp to prescribe controlled substances; to call in prescriptions for controlled substances  
3 to patients; and falsify records by indicating in the medical records that she was the treating  
4 physician at Las Vegas Health Center.
- 5 3. Dr. Jones admitted to being the Medical Director of Agape Health and only seeing the  
6 location one time and never meeting the staff or chiropractors on site. Agape Health would  
7 text her when they needed controlled substances, and Dr. Jones would call in the  
8 prescriptions. However, she never met the patients, never treated the patients and also  
9 allowed staff, unlicensed persons, to treat and inject patients with controlled substances.

10 As a result of the foregoing, the Investigative Committee reasonably determines and  
11 believes that due to Dr. Jones' aiding and abetting the unlicensed practice of medicine of  
12 Mr. Hoodbhoy, including his examining, diagnosing and treating of Nevada patients, along with  
13 his illegal use of Dr. Jones' authorized Board of Pharmacy signature stamp, the illegal dispensing  
14 of controlled substances and dangerous drugs, and Dr. Jones being the Medical Director of another  
15 health services office, that the health, safety and welfare of the public is at imminent risk of harm  
16 and that a summary suspension of Dr. Jones' license to practice medicine is necessary to remove  
17 said risk of imminent harm to the health, safety and welfare of the public.


18 Accordingly, pursuant to NRS 630.326(1):

19 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the license to practice medicine in the state of Nevada  
20 of Carmen Felice Jones, M.D. (License No. 10127) is **HEREBY SUSPENDED** until further order  
21 of the Investigative Committee or Board; and

22 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that a hearing in this matter be set within forty-five (45)  
23 days of the original Order that was filed on April 19, 2013, pursuant to NRS 630.326(2), to  
24 determine whether this suspension may continue, unless the parties mutually agree to a divergent  
25 time frame.


