NEVADA SUPREME COURT UPHOLDS REVOCATION OF LICENSE BY BOARD OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS

On March 17, 2006, the Board of Medical Examiners revoked the license to practice medicine in the state of Nevada of Mohammad Hassan Fani-Salek, finding from the evidence presented to it that Dr. Fani-Salek had violated NRS 630.304(1) by obtaining his license through the use of false and misleading documents.

Dr. Fani-Salek filed a petition for judicial review with the Eighth Judicial District Court of the state of Nevada, claiming that the Board of Medical Examiners' revocation of his license was arbitrary and capricious. The District Court denied the petition for judicial review, and Dr. Fani-Salek appealed that decision to the Nevada Supreme Court.

On May 28, 2008, the Nevada Supreme Court affirmed the District Court's decision to deny the petition for judicial review, thus affirming the Board of Medical Examiners' revocation of Dr. Fani-Salek's license, and concluding that the revocation was not arbitrary or capricious.
