SUBJECT: Changes to RP1 Draft of LCB File No. R068-23
DATE: April 24, 2024

The Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners (Board) has scheduled a public hearing on [R068-23](#) for 1:30 pm on May 7, 2024 in both the Reno and Las Vegas offices. During the workshop on this regulation on April 3, 2024, a couple of changes were noted and Board staff will request that the Board adopt the regulation with these changes. The intent of this Memorandum is to ensure that all licensees and interested parties are aware of these changes.

Section 19(1)(i), amending NAC 630.290, removing existing subsection (i) and changing existing subsection (j) to (i) so that the regulation reads:

~~(i) [Whether the applicant is using a prescription drug or other substance that may affect his or her ability to practice as a physician assistant; and]~~
~~(j) A public address and the mailing address at which the applicant prefers to receive correspondence from the Board.~~

Section 26(1)(a), amending NAC 630.505, removing existing subsection (i) and changing existing subsection (j) to (i) so that the regulation reads:

~~(i) [Whether the applicant is using a prescription drug or other substance that may affect his or her ability to practice respiratory care; and]~~
~~(j) A public address and the mailing address at which the applicant prefers to receive correspondence from the Board.~~

Section 27(1)(l), amending NAC 630.513, removing existing subsection (l) and changing existing subsection (m) to (l), so that the regulation reads:

~~(l) [Whether the applicant is using a prescription drug or other substance that may affect his or her ability to practice respiratory care; and]~~
~~(m)~~ *A public address [where the applicant may be contacted by the Board.] and the mailing address at which the applicant prefers to receive correspondence from the Board.*

Section 30(1)(j), amending NAC 630.700, removing existing subsection (j) and changing existing subsection (k) to (j) so that the regulation reads:

~~(j) [Whether the applicant is using a prescription drug or other substance that may affect his or her ability to practice perfusion; and]~~
~~(k)~~ *A public address and the mailing address at which the applicant prefers to receive correspondence from the Board.*

Section 31(1)(m), amending NAC 630.715, removing existing subsection (m) and changing existing subsection (n) to (m), so that the regulation reads:

~~(m) [Whether the applicant is using a prescription drug or other substance that may affect his or her ability to practice perfusion; and]~~
~~(n)~~ *A public address and the mailing address at which the applicant prefers to receive correspondence from the Board.*

Section 32, amending NAC 630.730. NAC 630.730 is no longer needed and instead of amending it, Board staff will request that the Board approve its repeal when this regulation is adopted. This change will be easier for perfusionists because they work at multiple locations.

Repeal of NAC 630.730:

~~[Before providing perfusion services, a perfusionist must notify the Board, on a form prescribed by the Board, of the name and location of the primary location of practice of the perfusionist. The form must be signed by the perfusionist.]~~
