January 19, 2017 1 2 **TO: Interstate Medical Licensure Compact Commissioners** 3 4 FR: IMLCC Bylaws & Rules Committee 5 6 RE: Seeking commissioners' comments on proposed rule on renewal of an 7 expedited license issued 8 9 Pursuant to the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact Commission's 10 administrative rule 1.4(b), the Bylaws and Rules Committee is seeking review 11 and comments from all commissioners on the following proposed amendments 12 to Administrative Rule Chapter 3 and Chapter 5 to express the expedited 13 licensure renewal process set forth in Section 7 of the Interstate Medical 14 Licensure Compact. The proposed rulemaking consists of three parts: 15 16 **Item 1.** A new subrule, 5.8, which expresses the renewal process consistent 17 with Section 7 of the Compact legislation. 18 19 Item 2. An amendment to 5.2(ee) to update the definition of service fee to 20 include a service fee for expedited licensure renewal. Amendment ensures 21 consistency in definition of a service fee. 22 23 **Items 3.4.5.** Amendments to Chapter 3 - Fees to update definition of service 24 fees to include a service fee for expedited licensure renewal. Ensures 25 consistency in definition of a service fee. 26 27 The draft rulemaking establishes that the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact 28 Commission may collect a service fee for services rendered by the commission 29 in the expedited licensure renewal process. The amount of this service fee will 30 be determined before the Commission votes to adopt the rule. 31 32 The Bylaws and Rules Committee will receive comments from 33 commissioners about the proposed rulemaking through January 34 28, 2017. Send comments by e-mail to mark.bowden@iowa.gov 35 Comments will be posted on licenseportability.org as they are 36 received. 37 38 The Bylaws and Rules Committee will consider commissioners' comments and 39 prepare a final draft and present it to initiate the formal rulemaking at the 40 Commission's teleconference on February 22, 2017. 41

HERE IS THE PROPOSED RULEMAKING
ITEM 1. Adopt the following <u>new</u> subrule 5.8:
5.8 Expedited licensure renewal and continued participation.
5.8(1) At least 90 days in advance of the expiration date of an expedited license,
the Interstate Commission shall notify the physician by e-mail of the pending
expiration and provide information on the process to renew the expedited license.
The e-mail notice shall be sent to the address specified in rule 2.2. The physician is
responsible for renewing the expedited license prior to its expiration. Failure of
the physician to receive a renewal notice does not relieve the physician of
responsibility for renewing the expedited license through the Interstate
Commission.
5.8(2) The physician shall complete an online renewal application on a form
provided by the Interstate Commission.
5.8 (3) The physician shall attest on an online form provided by the Interstate
Commission the following:

a. Maintains a full and unrestricted medical license in a state of principal license.

b. Has not been convicted, received adjudication, deferred adjudication, 65 community supervision, or deferred disposition for any offense by a court of 66 appropriate jurisdiction. 67 68 c. Has not had a license authorizing the practice of medicine subject to discipline 69 by a licensing agency in any state, federal, or foreign jurisdiction, excluding any 70 action related to nonpayment of fees related to a medical license. 71 72 **d.** Has not had a controlled substance license or permit suspended or revoked by a 73 state or the United States drug enforcement administration. 74 75 e. Complies with all continuing professional development or continuing medical 76 education requirements for renewal of a medical license issued by a member 77 state. 78 79 **5.8 (4)** The Interstate Commission may verify that the physician satisfies renewal 80 requirements in 5.8(3). 81 82 **5.8(5)** The Interstate Commission may collect a service fee from the physician for 83 renewal of an expedited license issued through the Compact. The Interstate 84

Commission shall retain 100 percent of this service fee for renewal of an expedited license.

5.8(6) The Interstate Commission shall collect any renewal fees charged for the renewal of an expedited license and distribute the fees to the applicable member board.

5.8(7) Upon receipt of any renewal fees collected in 5.8.(6), a member board shall renew the physician's expedited license.

5.8 (8) After the expedited license is renewed the member state may collect
 additional information from the physician related to that state's specific
 requirements for license renewal.

5.8(9) Physician information collected by the Interstate Commission during the renewal process will be available or provided as appropriate to all member boards.

5.8 (10) A physician who seeks to renew an expedited license after its expiration date may be subject to any and all penalties, terms and conditions for licensure renewal established by the member state that issued the expedited license.

122	is not a license fee for the issuance of an expedited license or the renewal of an
123	expedited license.
