CCMS has provided a number of Covid-19 related Townhall events, free of charge, to Clark County physicians to keep them apprised of the changes that have come in diagnosis, testing, treatment and vaccines. Attendance has reached 200 in individual offerings.

www.clarkcountymedical.org, the society website has been updated on more than a weekly basis to keep the most current information on all things related to Covid-19 available. The speakers bureau members have been interviewed a number of times on specialized topics for both print and live media. CCMS strives to provide physician experts to the media.

All events at this time remain on a virtual basis and have included a Research Abstract and Poster Contest for medical students and residents. There were 51 entries with 6 prize winners. Entries came from both UNLV and Touro. Abstracts will be published in the County Line online magazine. A Residents Job Fair will conclude on Feb 18, again, virtual from 4-6 pm. All residents are invited to meet with various employers, hear lectures on CV building, interviewing, debt management, quality practice and medical legal issues. Spots are still available at this time for both employers and attendees.

Plans are being made to present CME for license required topics in late spring. Suicide Prevention and Opioid Prescribing and Abuse will be presented. Currently there is a monthly Vaccine Update presented and an additional monthly meeting on legislative update will be held for all members.

CCMS will begin a member recruitment project in the next 90 days and we invite all Clark County physicians to join. Elections are pending and a new board will take its place in May of 2021. Staff will return to the office as of March 1.
