5. Review and Discussion About Increasing the Maximum Fine Charged in Disciplinary Actions Pursuant to NRS 630.352(4)(h) *(for possible action)*
The Subcommittee will review and discuss NRS 630.352(4)(h) and decide whether to pursue increasing the maximum fine that may be assessed for each violation of law found by the Board in a disciplinary matter. The maximum fine amount of \$5,000 was set by the Nevada Legislature in 1985.
6. Review and Discussion Regarding the Disposition of Fines Collected by the Board in Disciplinary Matters Pursuant to NRS 630.110(4)(b) *(for possible action)*
The Subcommittee will review and discuss NRS 630.110(4)(b) and decide whether to pursue changing this provision to allow fines collected by the Board in disciplinary matters to be directed in a manner that allows for the improvement of healthcare and/or the practice of medicine in the State of Nevada.
