



# Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners

## Notice of Workshop to Solicit Comments on Proposed Regulations

The Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners (Board), located at 9600 Gateway Drive, Reno, Nevada 89521, (775) 688-2559, is proposing a regulation pertaining to Chapter 630 of the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC). The public workshop has been set for 1:30 p.m. on Wednesday, April 3, 2024, at the Board's Reno office located at 9600 Gateway Drive, Reno, Nevada 89521, and video-conferenced to the at the Board's Las Vegas office located at 325 E. Warm Springs Road, Suite 225, Las Vegas, Nevada 89119. The purpose of this workshop is to solicit comments from interested persons on the following general topics that may be addressed in the proposed regulations:

- R068-23** This regulation draft prescribes the conditions under which the Board of Medical Examiners will deem a license to be in good standing; revises provisions regarding the issuance, renewal, denial, and expiration of certain licenses; revises the requirements relating to continuing education of physicians and physician assistants; requires informed consent before a physician or physician assistant provides certain care or treatment to a patient; prohibits a physician or physician assistant from requiring or asking a patient to waive certain rights; makes revisions concerning the reimbursement of certain witnesses at a hearing of the board; revises provisions governing the approval of a physician to supervise certain physicians assistants or collaborate with certain advanced practice registered nurses under certain circumstances; revises the time by which a collaborating physician must notify the Board of the termination of the collaboration with an advanced practice registered nurse; requires a collaborating physician to limit the controlled substances that certain advanced practice registered nurses may prescribe; clarifies provisions prohibiting the falsification of medical records; requires a perfusionist to notify the Board of any update to his or her primary location of practice after changing such a location; repeals certain provisions governing disciplinary action against physician assistants and practitioners of respiratory care; and provides other matters properly relating thereto.
