COMPLAINT

The Investigative Committee of the Board of Medical Examiners of the state of Nevada, composed of Charles N. Held, M.D., Chairman, Cindy Lamerson, M.D., Member, and Jean Stoess, M.A., Member, by and through Lyn E. Beggs, General Counsel for the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners, having a reasonable basis to believe that Carlos Ermocilla, M.D., has violated the provisions of NRS Chapter 630, hereby issues its formal Complaint, stating the Investigative Committee's charges and allegations, as follows:

1. Dr. Ermocilla is currently licensed in active status, and was so licensed by the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners, hereinafter referred to as "the Board," on September 22, 2004 (License No. 11167), pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 630 of the Nevada Revised Statutes, and at all times addressed herein was so licensed.

2. Patient A was a fifty-five year old female at the time of the events set forth herein. Her true identify is not disclosed to protect her privacy, but her identity is disclosed in the Patient Designation served on Dr. Ermocilla along with a copy of this Complaint.

3. On October 13, 2005, Patient A presented to the Harmon Medical Center, an urgent care center, at 4:26 a.m. with complaints of vomiting and diarrhea for the preceding five hours. Patient A also reported weakness and tingling in her extremities and was seen by Dr. Ermocilla.

4. Upon admission, Patient A's blood pressure was 140/88.

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
3. That the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners determine what sanctions to impose for the violation or violations committed by Respondent; and




