COMPLAINT

The Investigative Committee of the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners (Board), composed of Charles N. Held, M.D., Theodore B. Berndt, M.D., and Ms. Renee West, by and through Edward O. Cousineau, General Counsel for the Board and Attorney for the Investigative Committee, having a reasonable basis to believe that Conrad R. Murray, M.D., hereinafter referred to as "Respondent," has violated the provisions of NRS Chapter 630, hereby issues its formal Complaint, stating the Investigative Committee's charges and allegations, as follows:

- 1. Respondent was licensed in active status to practice medicine in the State of Nevada on August 17, 1999, and was so licensed by the Board, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 630 of the Nevada Revised Statutes.
- 2. On or about June 13, 2007, the Board received Respondent's Application for Registration Renewal of License for the 2007-2009 biennial registration period. One of the questions in the Application asked, "Are you out of compliance with court ordered child support?" Respondent answered in the negative.
- 3. On or about June 19, 2009, the Board received Respondent's Application for Registration Renewal of License for the 2009-2011 biennial registration period. One of the questions in the Application asked, "Are you out of compliance with court ordered child support?" Respondent again answered in the negative.

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- 4. Precedent to the filing of this Complaint, the Board came to learn that Respondent was in arrears, and not in compliance, with a court ordered child support obligation which originated out of the state of California. In June of 2007, Respondent's child support arrearages totaled \$7,255.86, and in June of 2009, Respondent's child support arrearages totaled \$10,131.05.
- 5. Based upon the foregoing, Respondent failed to notice the Board in either his 2007-2009 or 2009-2011 Registration Renewal of Licensure Applications that he was in arrears and out of compliance with a court ordered child support obligation.
- 6. Section 630.304(1) of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) provides that obtaining, maintaining or renewing or attempting to obtain, maintain or renew a license to practice medicine by bribery, fraud or misrepresentation or by any false, misleading, inaccurate or incomplete statement is grounds for disciplinary action.
- 7. Respondent violated NRS 630.304(1) when he twice failed to disclose to the Board that he was out of compliance with his court ordered child support obligation, and is subject to discipline by the Board as provided in NRS 630.352.

WHEREFORE, the Investigative Committee prays:

- 1. That the Board set a time and place for a formal hearing;
- 2. That the Board give Respondent notice of the charges herein against him, the time and place set for the hearing, and the possible sanctions against him;
- 3. That the Board determine what sanctions it determines to impose for the violation or violations committed by Respondent;
- 4. That the Board make, issue and serve on Respondent its findings of facts, conclusions of law and order, in writing, that includes the sanctions imposed;
- 5. That the Board take such other and further action as may be just and proper in these premises.
