## ORDER OF SUMMARY SUSPENSION

On August 18, 2010, Board Staff presented evidence and information to the Investigative Committee, composed of Charles N. Held, M.D., Chair, Theodore Berndt, M.D., Member, and Valerie Clark, BNS, RHU, LUTCF, Member, regarding Anthony Cruz, C.R.T. Upon review of the evidence and information presented by Board Staff, the Investigative Committee hereby **IMMEDIATELY SUSPENDS** the license to practice respiratory care of Anthony Cruz, C.R.T 14 (hereinafter "Mr. Cruz") pursuant to NRS 630.326(1) based upon the following preliminary findings:

1. Mr. Cruz is licensed to practice respiratory care in the state of Nevada and was 17 originally licensed on December 31, 2001. 18

2. On August 3, 2010 Mr. Cruz was working at Summerlin Hospital and was reported to 19 be exhibiting signs of impairment. Mr. Cruz was requested to submit to a ten-panel urine drug screen 20 and he agreed to do so. 21

3. Results of the drug screen were forwarded to Summerlin Hospital a few days later and 22 showed that Mr. Cruz was positive for methamphetamine at the time of the test. 23

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On August 9, 2010, Mr. Cruz was terminated from Summerlin Hospital

The Investigative Committee believes that due to Mr. Cruz's use of an illegal narcotic 25 substance, specifically methamphetamine, and being under its influence while providing respiratory 26 care, that the health, safety and welfare of the public is at imminent risk of harm and that a summary 27 suspension of Mr. Cruz's license to practice respiratory care is necessary to remove said risk of 28

1	imminent harm to the health, safety and welfare of the public. Accordingly, pursuant to			
2	NRS 630.326(1): <b>IT IS HEREBY ORDERED</b> that the license to practice respiratory care in the state of New local Authors Core CDT. (License No. DC502) is hereber and the till for the state of the
