




1 Propofol or any other heavy sedative medication used as anesthesia, as long as Dr. Murray does
2 not personally prescribe or administer these medications.

3 Further, Dr. Murray has cooperated in the investigation regarding this Stipulation and
4 agrees that the aforementioned restrictions on his medical practice in the state of Nevada shall not
5 be modified, stayed or removed, until there is a final resolution of the criminal allegations in
6 California or until the Board takes other action to modify the Order so as to properly reflect the
7 terms of bail as they may be modified in California. Once the referenced criminal matters are
8 resolved, or at any time prior thereto, Dr. Murray may petition the Investigative Committee in
9 writing for removal or revision of this stipulation by showing that the bail requirements are no
10 longer in effect or have been modified, stayed or removed.




