## **COMPLAINT**

The Investigative Committee of the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners ("Board"), of filing of Benjamin Rodriguez, M.D., Chairman, composed at the time Beverly A. Neyland, M.D., Member, and Donna A. Ruthe, Member, by and through Bradley O. Van Ry, Deputy General Counsel, having a reasonable basis to believe that Dianna Jean Thomas, M.D., hereinafter referred to as "Respondent", has violated the provisions of NRS Chapter 630, hereby issues its formal Complaint, stating the Investigative Committee's charges and allegations, as follows:

Respondent is currently licensed in active status (License No. 7097), and has been
 so licensed since June 11, 1994 by the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners pursuant to the
 provisions of Chapter 630 of the Nevada Revised Statutes.

22 2. Patient A was a six (6) year old male at the time of the incidents in question. His true
23 identity is not disclosed to protect his privacy, but his identity is disclosed in the Patient
24 Designation served on Respondent along with a copy of this Complaint.

3. Patient B was a sixteen (16) year old male at the time of the incidents in question. His
true identity is not disclosed to protect his privacy, but his identity is disclosed in the Patient
Designation served on Respondent along with a copy of this Complaint.

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4. Patient C was a four (4) year old male at the time of the incidents in question. His true identity is not disclosed to protect his privacy, but his identity is disclosed in the Patient Designation served on Respondent along with a copy of this Complaint.

5. On June 30, 2011, the Investigative Committee issued an order to Respondent pursuant to NRS §630.311(1) ordering her appearance before the committee to address the pending investigations, her medical practice in general, her specialty, the community standard of care and her complaint history with the Board. The appearance date and time was scheduled for Tuesday, August 23, 2011 at 10:30 a.m. at the offices of the Board located at 1105 Terminal Way #301, Reno, NV 89502.

6. Service of the order was made by mailing a true copy by the US Postal Service Certified Mail on July 19, 2011 pursuant to NRS §630.244.

7. Acceptance of service was made on behalf of Respondent on July 19, 2011.
8. On August 23, 2011, Respondent did not appear before the Investigative Committee as ordered.

9. As to Patients A, B and C, Respondent received numerous requests for the medical
files/records of each patient. At no time has Respondent made the medical records available for
inspection or copying as required by law.

18 10. Further, Respondent closed her medical practice and terminated patient care of the
19 three (3) aforementioned patients without providing adequate notice to those patients.

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#### Count I

21 11. All of the allegations in the above paragraphs are hereby incorporated as if fully set
22 forth herein.

12. Nevada Revised Statute Section 630.3065(2)(a) provides that the willful failure to
comply with an Order of a committee designated by the Board to investigate a complaint against a
physician is grounds for initiating discipline against a licensee.

2613. By reason of the foregoing, Respondent is subject to discipline by the Nevada State27Board of Medical Examiners as provided in Section 630.352 of the Nevada Revised Statutes.

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### <u>Count II</u>

2 14. All of the allegations in the above paragraphs are hereby incorporated as if fully set
3 forth herein.

15. Nevada Revised Statute Section 630.3062(4) provides that the failure to make the
medical records of a patient available for inspection and copying as provided in NRS 629.061 is
grounds for initiating discipline against a licensee.

16. By reason of the foregoing, Respondent is subject to discipline by the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners as provided in Section 630.352 of the Nevada Revised Statutes.

#### Count III

17. All of the allegations in the above paragraphs are hereby incorporated as if fully set forth herein.

18. Nevada Revised Statute Section 630.304(7) provides that terminating the medical care of a patient without adequate notice or without making other arrangements for the continued care of a patient is grounds for initiating discipline against a licensee.

19.By reason of the foregoing, Respondent is subject to discipline by the Nevada StateBoard of Medical Examiners as provided in Section 630.352 of the Nevada Revised Statutes.

#### Count IV

20. All of the allegations in the above paragraphs are hereby incorporated as if fully set forth herein.

20 21. Nevada Revised Statute Section 630.301(9) provides that the engaging in conduct 21 that brings the medical profession into disrepute is grounds for initiating discipline against a 22 licensee.

23 22. By reason of the foregoing, Respondent is subject to discipline by the Nevada State
24 Board of Medical Examiners as provided in Section 630.352 of the Nevada Revised Statutes.

WHEREFORE, the Investigative Committee prays:

1. That the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners give Respondent notice of the
charges herein against her and give her notice that she may file an answer to the Complaint herein
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as set forth in Section 630.339 of the Nevada Revised Statutes within twenty (20) days of service
 of the Complaint.

2. That the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners set a time and place for a formal hearing after holding an Early Case Conference pursuant to NRS §630.339(3);

3. That the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners determine what sanctions it determines to impose if it determines there has been a violation or violations of the Medical Practice Act (Nevada Revised Statutes Chapter 630) committed by Respondent; and

4. That the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners make, issue and serve on Respondent its findings of facts, conclusions of law and order, in writing, that includes the sanctions imposed; and

5. That the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners take such other and further
action as may be just and proper in these premises.
