COMPLAINT

The Investigative Committee of the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners, composed at the time filing of the instant Complaint was approved of Theodore B. Berndt, M.D., Ms. Valerie Clark, BSN, RHU, LUTCF, and Michael Fischer, M.D., having a reasonable basis to believe that Karen Arcotta, M.D., hereinafter referred to as Dr. Arcotta, has violated the provisions of NRS Chapter 630, hereby issues its formal Complaint, stating the Investigative Committee's charges and allegations, as follows:

Dr. Arcotta is licensed to practice medicine in the state of Nevada
 (License No. 4896), and was originally licensed on July 9, 1983 by the Nevada State Board of
 Medical Examiners pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 630 of the Nevada Revised Statutes.

21 2. In August 2011, as part of normal protocol, an investigator for the Nevada State
22 Board of Medical Examiners had multiple contacts with Dr. Arcotta as part of an on-going
23 investigation. In the course of these contacts, the investigator witnessed erratic behavior on the
24 part of Dr. Arcotta. Such erratic behavior had also been reported to the investigator by former
25 co-workers of Dr. Arcotta, including one incident involving a physical altercation with another
26 staff member.

3. In the course of the on-going investigation, Dr. Arcotta was ordered to submit to a psychiatric evaluation by the Investigative Committee of the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners pursuant to Nevada Revised Statute (NRS) Section 630.318.

4. The findings of the ordered evaluation indicated that Dr. Arcotta is currently not able to safely practice medicine and based on a review of all available information, the Investigative Committee issued its Order summarily suspending the license to practice medicine of Dr. Arcotta pursuant to NRS 630.326(1) on September 22, 2011.

5. During the course of the investigation, it was discovered that on March 16, 2011. Dr. Arcotta was convicted of misdemeanor Driving Under the Influence in Las Vegas Township Justice Court for an arrest made on November 23, 2009. Dr. Arcotta failed to timely report the conviction to the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners.

6. On June 26, 2011, Dr. Arcotta renewed her license to practice medicine in the state of Nevada which asks for information for the time period since the previous license renewal period. Dr. Arcotta answered negatively to question #6 which asks in part "[h]ave you been arrested, investigated for, charged with, convicted or pled guilty or nolo contendere to any offense or violation of federal...state, or local law...which is a misdemeanor, gross misdemeanor, felony...excluding any minor traffic offense (driving or being in control of a motor vehicle while under the influence of a chemical substance, including alcohol, is not considered a minor traffic offense)" and failed to disclose either the November 2009 arrest or the March 2011 conviction when renewing her license.

7. 21 The license to practice medicine of Dr. Arcotta remains suspended at the time of 22 the filing of this Complaint.

Count I

8. NRS 630.306(13) provides that failure to be found competent to practice medicine as a result of an examination to determine medical competency pursuant to NRS 630.318 is grounds for initiating disciplinary action against a physician.

9. 1 Dr. Arcotta was found to be unable to safely practice medicine after submitting to a 2 psychiatric evaluation order by the Investigative Committee pursuant to NRS 630.318 and 3 accordingly is in violation of NRS 630.306(13).

10. By reason of the foregoing, Dr. Arcotta is subject to discipline by the Nevada State 4 5 Board of Medical Examiners as provided in NRS 630.352.

Count II

11. NRS 630.306(12) provides that failure of a licensee to report in writing, within 30 days, any criminal action taken or conviction obtained against the licensee, other than a minor traffic violation in this State, or any other state, is grounds for initiating disciplinary action against a physician.

12. Dr. Arcotta failed to report to the Board her March 16, 2011 conviction for a misdemeanor Driving Under the Influence in Las Vegas Township Justice Court within 30 days of the conviction and to do has failed to report the conviction and accordingly is in violation of NRS 630.306(12).

13. By reason of the foregoing, Dr. Arcotta is subject to discipline by the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners as provided NRS 630.352.

Count IV

NRS 630.304(1) provides that obtaining, maintaining, or renewing a license to 14. 18 19 practice medicine by bribery, fraud or misrepresentation or by any false, misleading, inaccurate or incomplete statement is grounds for initiating disciplinary action against a physician. 20

15. Dr. Arcotta answered negatively to question #6 on her renewal application 21 regarding whether she had been arrested or convicted in the time period specified within the 22 application, which is a false, misleading and inaccurate statement and accordingly, Dr. Arcotta is 23 in violation of NRS 630.304(1). 24

16. By reason of the foregoing, Dr. Arcotta is subject to discipline by the Nevada State 25 26 Board of Medical Examiners as provided NRS 630.352.

WHEREFORE, the Investigative Committee prays:

1. That the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners give Dr. Arcotta notice of the charges herein against her and give her notice that she may file an answer to the Complaint herein as set forth in NRS 630.339 within twenty (20) days of service of the Complaint.

2. That the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners set a time and place for a formal hearing after holding an Early Case Conference pursuant to NRS 630.339(3);

3. That the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners determine what sanctions it determines to impose if it determines there has been a violation or violations of the Medical Practice Act (Nevada Revised Statutes Chapter 630) committed by Dr. Arcotta; and

4. That the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners make, issue and serve on Dr. Arcotta its findings of facts, conclusions of law and order, in writing, that includes the sanctions imposed; and

5. That the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners take such other and further action as may be just and proper in these premises.
