

10 **COMPLAINT**

11 The Investigative Committee¹ (IC) of the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners (Board)
12 hereby issues this formal Complaint (Complaint) against Hugh Arthur Burt, M.D. (Respondent), a
13 physician licensed in Nevada. After investigating this matter, the IC has a reasonable basis to
14 believe that Respondent has violated provisions of Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) Chapter 630 and
15 Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) Chapter 630 (collectively, the Medical Practice Act). The IC
16 alleges the following facts:

17 1. Respondent is licensed in Nevada in active status (License No. 8725) and was
18 licensed by the Board on July 10, 1998.

19 2. On or about January 19, 2017, Respondent was arrested for Driving Under the
20 Influence (DUI) by Las Vegas Metropolitan Police and this was his second DUI arrest.

21 3. On or about June 29, 2017, Respondent submitted his biennial renewal application.
22 On that application, Respondent answered, "NO" to the question, "[h]ave you been: a) asked
23 to respond to an investigation; b) notified that you were under investigation for; c) investigated
24 for; d) charged with; or e) convicted of any violation of a statute, rule or regulation governing
25 your practice as a physician by any medical licensing board, hospital, medical society,
26 governmental entity or agency other than the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners?"

Count I

NRS 630.304(1)

(Dishonesty in Renewing a License)

4. All of the allegations contained in the above paragraphs are hereby incorporated by reference as though fully set forth herein.

5. NRS 630.304(1) provides that renewing a license to practice medicine by fraud or misrepresentation or by any false, misleading, inaccurate or incomplete statement is grounds for initiating disciplinary action or denying licensure.

6. Respondent renewed his license to practice medicine by fraud and misrepresentation and by a false, misleading, inaccurate and incomplete statement by answering "NO" to the following question on his June 29, 2017, Nevada medical license renewal application:

Have you been: a) asked to respond to an investigation; b) notified that you are under investigation for; c) investigated for; d) charged with; or e) convicted of any violation of a statute, rule or regulation governing your practice as a physician by any medical licensing board . . . other than the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners?

7. By reason of the foregoing, Respondent is subject to discipline by the Nevada Board as provided in NRS 630.352.

WHEREFORE, the Investigative Committee prays:

1. That the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners give Respondent notice of the charges herein against him and give him notice that he may file an answer to the Complaint herein as set forth in NRS 630.339(2) within twenty (20) days of service of the Complaint;

2. That the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners set a time and place for a formal hearing after holding an Early Case Conference pursuant to NRS 630.339(3);

3. That the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners determine what sanctions to impose if it determines there has been a violation or violations of the Medical Practice Act committed by Respondent;


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4. That the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners make, issue and serve on Respondent its findings of fact, conclusions of law and order, in writing, that includes the sanctions imposed; and

5. That the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners take such other and further action as may be just and proper in these premises.
