

1 Interpretation within six (6) months of the Order; (b) obey all laws; (c) tolling of probation if Respondent is
2 not practicing medicine in Arizona for a period of time exceeding thirty days.

4 **NRS 630.301(3)**

5 **(Disciplinary Action by Another Licensing Board)**

6 5. All of the allegations contained in the above paragraphs are hereby incorporated by
7 reference as though fully set forth herein.

8 6. NRS 630.301(3) provides that any disciplinary action, including the revocation,
9 suspension, modification or limitation of a license to practice any type of medicine, taken by another state,
10 constitute grounds for initiating disciplinary action against a licensee.

11 7. On or about September 16, 2016, the Arizona Medical Board issued an Order for Letter of
12 Reprimand and Probation; and Consent to the Same to Respondent.

13 8. The Order for Letter of Reprimand and Probation; and Consent to the Same was a
14 disciplinary action taken by another state.

15 9. By reason of the foregoing, Respondent is subject to discipline by the Nevada State Board
16 of Medical Examiners as provided in NRS 630.352.

17 **WHEREFORE**, the Investigative Committee prays:

18 1. That the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners give Respondent notice of the charges
19 herein against him and give him notice that he may file an answer to the Complaint herein as set forth in
20 NRS 630.339(2) within twenty (20) days of service of the Complaint;

21 2. That the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners set a time and place for a formal
22 hearing after holding an Early Case Conference pursuant to NRS 630.339(3);

23 3. That the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners determine what sanctions to impose if
24 it determines there has been a violation or violations of the Medical Practice Act committed by
25 Respondent;


26 4. That the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners make, issue and serve on
27 Respondent its findings of fact, conclusions of law and order, in writing, that includes the sanctions
28 imposed; and

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5. That the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners take such other and further action as may be just and proper in these premises.


