10 **COMPLAINT**

11 The Investigative Committee (IC)¹ of the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners
12 (Board), by and through Aaron Bart Fricke, Esq., Senior Deputy General Counsel and attorney for
13 the IC, having a reasonable basis to believe that Clinton Anderson, PA-C (Respondent), violated the
14 provisions of Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) Chapter 630 and Nevada Administrative Code (NAC)
15 Chapter 630 (collectively, the Medical Practice Act), hereby issues its Complaint, stating the IC's
16 charges and allegations as follows:

17 1. Respondent was at all times relevant to this Complaint a licensed physician
18 assistant holding an active license to practice medicine in the State of Nevada (License No.
19 PA1203). Respondent was licensed by the Board on February 16, 2010.

20 2. Patient A was a 73-year-old male at the time of the incidents in question. His name
21 is not disclosed in this Complaint to protect his identity, but his identity is disclosed in the Patient
22 Designation contemporaneously served on Respondent with a copy of this Complaint.

23 3. Respondent was at all times relevant to this Complaint professionally supervised by
24 Dhaval Jasantbhai Shah, M.D. (Dr. Shah). At all times relevant to this Complaint, Dr. Shah
25 practiced in the areas of infectious diseases and internal medicine, in Las Vegas, Nevada.
