### **COMPLAINT**

The Investigative Committee (IC) of the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners (Board), by and through Aaron Bart Fricke, J.D., General Counsel and attorney for the IC, having a reasonable basis to believe that ADELBERT SCOTT WADSWORTH, PA-C (Respondent) violated the provisions of Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) Chapter 630 and Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) Chapter 630 (collectively, the Medical Practice Act), hereby issues its Complaint, stating the IC's charges and allegations as follows:

- 1. Respondent was at all times relative to this Complaint a physician assistant holding an active license to practice medicine in the State of Nevada (License No. PA1449). Respondent was originally licensed by the Board on August 13, 2013.
  - 2. Pursuant to NRS 630.020(1), the "Practice of medicine" means:
    - 1. To diagnose, treat, correct, prevent or **prescribe** for any human disease, ailment, injury, infirmity, deformity or other condition, physical or mental, by any means or instrumentality, including, but not limited to, the performance of an autopsy. [emphasis added].

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- 3. Pursuant to NAC 630.375(2) a physician assistant shall not perform medical services without supervision from his or her supervising physician, except in life-threatening and emergency situations.
- 4. Pursuant to NAC 630.380(1)(c), performing medical services otherwise than in a life-threatening or emergency situation, and otherwise than with supervision from a supervising physician, is grounds for initiating disciplinary action against a physician assistant.
- NAC 630.380(1)(m) provides that violating any provision of NRS 630.301 to 5. 630.3065, is grounds for initiating disciplinary action against a physician assistant.
- 6. NRS 630.3062 provides that failure to maintain timely, legible, accurate and complete medical records relating to the diagnosis, treatment and care of a patient is grounds for initiating disciplinary action or denying licensure.

### COUNT I

### NAC 630.380(1)(c) – Performance of Medical Services Without a Supervising Physician

- 7. All of the allegations contained in the above paragraphs are hereby incorporated by reference as though fully set forth herein.
- 8. Respondent performed medical services otherwise than in a life-threatening or emergency situation, and without the supervision of a supervising physician, when, on July 27, 2020, he wrote a prescription for Ambien 10 mg, QHS, 30 ct., with five (5) refills, for Patient A<sup>2</sup> to treat insomnia.
- By reason of the foregoing, Respondent is subject to discipline by the Board as provided in NRS 630.352.

### **COUNT II**

### NRS 630.3062(1)(a) – Failure to Maintain Proper Medical Records

All of the allegations contained in the above paragraphs are hereby incorporated 10. by reference as though fully set forth herein.

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11.	Respondent failed to maintain complete medical records relating to the diagnosis
treatment, and	care of Patient A by failing to maintain any records whatsoever of his diagnosis
treatment, and	care of Patient A.

12. By reason of the foregoing, Respondent is subject to discipline by the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners as provided in NRS 630.352.

### WHEREFORE, the Investigative Committee prays:

- 1. That the Board give Respondent notice of the charges herein against him and give him notice that he may file an answer to the Complaint herein as set forth in NRS 630.339(2) within twenty (20) days of service of the Complaint;
- 2. That the Board set a time and place for a formal hearing after holding an Early Case Conference pursuant to NRS 630.339(3);
- 3. That the Board determine what sanctions to impose if it determines there has been a violation or violations of the Medical Practice Act committed by Respondent;
- 4. That the Board award fees and costs for the investigation and prosecution of this case as outlined in NRS 622.400;
- 5. That the Board make, issue, and serve on Respondent its findings of fact, conclusions of law and order, in writing, that includes the sanctions imposed; and
- 6. That the Board take such other and further action as may be just and proper in these premises.
