10 **ORDER DENYING APPLICATION FOR LICENSURE**

11 The application of Zvika Jacob Schreiber, M.D. (Applicant), for a license to practice medicine
12 in the State of Nevada came before the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners (Board) at its
13 regularly scheduled meeting on Friday, March 5, 2021. The meeting of the Board was held exclusively
14 through telephonic means pursuant to the Emergency Directives issued by the Governor of Nevada, and
15 a quorum was present. The Applicant appeared telephonically in pro per.

16 At the appearance, proof was made to the satisfaction of the Board that the application ought to
17 be denied.

18 **IT IS SO ORDERED** that the application be, and hereby is, DENIED because the application
19 contained false, misleading, inaccurate and incomplete statements in violation of NRS 630.304(1),
20 which constitutes sufficient grounds for denying licensure. Further, the application contains the same,
21 repeated false, misleading, inaccurate and incomplete statements as Applicant made to other state
22 medical boards, for which Applicant was previously disciplined by those other boards, which also
23 constitutes sufficient grounds for denying licensure pursuant to NRS 630.301(3).



25 ¹ **NRS 630.200 Delay or denial of application for license to practice medicine: Grounds; notice; appeal.** 1)
26 The Board may deny an application for a license to practice medicine for any violation of the provisions of this chapter or
27 regulations of the Board. 2) The Board shall notify an applicant of any deficiency which prevents any further action on
28 the application or results in the denial of the application. The applicant may respond in writing to the Board concerning any
deficiency and, if the applicant does so, the Board shall respond in writing to the contentions of the applicant. 3) Any
unsuccessful applicant may appeal to the Board if the applicant files the appeal within 90 days after the date of the rejection
of the application by the Board. Upon appeal, the applicant has the burden to show that the action of the Board is
