NEVADA STATE BOARD OF AL EXAMINERS

COMPLAINT

The Investigative Committee¹ (IC) of the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners (Board), by and through William P. Shogren, Deputy General Counsel and attorney for the IC, having a reasonable basis to believe that Jill Allison Oliver, M.D., (Respondent) violated the provisions of Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) Chapter 630 and Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) Chapter 630 (collectively, the Medical Practice Act), hereby issues its Complaint, stating the IC's charges and allegations as follows:

- Respondent was at all times relative to this Complaint a medical doctor holding an 1. active license to practice medicine in the State of Nevada (License No. 11484). Respondent was originally licensed by the Board on July 1, 2005.
- Respondent, at all times relevant to this Complaint, held active Certificates of 2. Registration with the Nevada State Board of Pharmacy (Pharmacy Board), Nos. PD00349, PD15479, CS20010, and CS15479.
- On July 23, 2021, the Pharmacy Board filed a First Amended Notice of Intended 3. Action and Accusation (Accusation) against Respondent, alleging that between 2019 and 2020, while acting as owner and medical director of Glimpse Medical, Respondent violated various statutes and regulations within the Pharmacy Board's jurisdiction.

- 4. In pertinent part, the Pharmacy Board Accusation alleged that Respondent permitted a Glimpse Medical employee to perform dispensing technician duties without an active dispensing technican license, from approximately July 1, 2019 to January 23, 2020.
- 5. On September 10, 2021, the Pharmacy Board issued a Findings of Facts, Conclusions of Law, and Order (Order), hereto attached as **Exhibit 1**. The Pharmacy Board found that Respondent allowed her employee to act as a dispensing technician without a renewed license/registration, and performed her duty as the overseeing dispensing practitioner in an incompetent, unskillful or negligent manner and engaged in unprofessional conduct and conduct contrary to the public interest, in violation of NAC 639.7425(2), NAC 639.744, NAC 639.7445, and NAC 639.945(1)(i) and (j). Additionally, the Pharmacy Board found that Respondent, as owner/operator of Glimpse Medical, was responsible for the acts or omissions of its employees/personnel, pursuant to NAC 639.945(2).
- 6. The Pharmacy Board, in its Order, ordered that Respondent be disciplined as follows: (1) that the Order serve as a public reprimand; and (2) that Respondent pay a fine and also reimburse the Pharmacy Board for the costs incurred in investigating and prosecuting the matter.

COUNT I

NRS 630.306(1)(b)(3) – Violation of Statutes and Regulations of the Nevada State Board of Pharmacy

- 7. All of the allegations contained in the above paragraphs are hereby incorporated by reference as though fully set forth herein.
- 8. Respondent is a practitioner as defined by NRS 639.0125(1), as a physician who holds a license to practice medicine in the State of Nevada.
- 9. NRS 630.306(1)(b)(3) provides that engaging in conduct that violates a provision of Chapter 639 of NRS, or a regulation adopted by the Pharmacy Board pursuant thereto, that is applicable to a licensee who is a practitioner, as defined in NRS 639.0125, is grounds for initiating discipline against a licensee.

- NAC 639.7425(2), NAC 639.744, NAC 639.7445, and NAC 639.945(2) are 11. regulations adopted by the Pharmacy Board.
- 12. Respondent violated NRS 630.306(1)(b)(3) when the Pharmacy Board issued its Order and found that Respondent violated NAC 639.7425(2), NAC 639.744, and NAC 639.7445. See Exhibit 1.
- By reason of the foregoing, Respondent is subject to discipline by the Board as 13. provided in NRS 630.352.

WHEREFORE, the Investigative Committee prays:

- 1. That the Board give Respondent notice of the charges herein against her and give him notice that she may file an answer to the Complaint herein as set forth in NRS 630.339(2) within twenty (20) days of service of the Complaint;
- 2. That the Board set a time and place for a formal hearing after holding an Early Case Conference pursuant to NRS 630.339(3);
- 3. That the Board determine what sanctions to impose if it determines there has been a violation or violations of the Medical Practice Act committed by Respondent;
- 4. That the Board award fees and costs for the investigation and prosecution of this case as outlined in NRS 622.400;
- 5. That the Board make, issue and serve on Respondent its findings of fact, conclusions of law and order, in writing, that includes the sanctions imposed; and



FINDINGS OF FACTS, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW, AND ORDER

JILL OLIVER, MD, Certificate of Registration Nos. PD00349, PD15479, CS20010, CS15479,

This matter came before the Nevada State Board of Pharmacy ("Board") at its regularly scheduled meeting on Wednesday, September 1, 2021, in Las Vegas, Nevada. Courtney K. Lee, Esq., appeared and prosecuted the case before the Board. Respondent Jill Oliver, MD ("Oliver"), Certificate of Registration Nos. PD00349, PD15479, CS20010, CS15479 represented herself in proper person. Upon hearing the case, and based upon the evidence presented, the Board determines the following Findings of Facts, Conclusions of Law, and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACTS

The allegations against Respondent, as stated in the First Amended Notice of Intended Action and Accusation ("Amended Accusation") dated July 23, 2021 on file herein, and Answer filed by Respondent Oliver on June 28, 2021, requested by Respondent to be deemed the Answer for the Amended Accusation, and upon which the Board made findings of facts, are as follows:

- 1. The Board has jurisdiction over Respondent and this matter.
- 2. Respondent Oliver owns/operates Glimpse Medical ("Glimpse"), a medical practice, and served as the medical director during all relevant timeframes.

- 3. Dianne Racosas ("Racosas") was employed by Glimpse during the relevant timeframes, and performed dispensing technician duties.
- 4. From approximately 2013-2016, Racosas was a licensed dispensing technician for Dr. Oliver. Racosas then took an extended leave. Racosas did not renew her dispensing technician license after 2016.
- 5. From approximately July 1, 2019 to January 23, 2020, Racosas performed dispensing technician duties without an active dispensing technician license.
- 6. Dr. Oliver permitted Racosas to be employed in the capacity of dispensing technician at Glimpse without an active dispensing license for approximately 115 days.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Based upon the foregoing findings of facts, the Board concludes as a matter of law:

- 7. Respondent Oliver allowed Racosas to act as a dispensing technician without a renewed licensed/registration, performed her duty as the overseeing dispensing practitioner in an incompetent, unskillful or negligent manner and engaged in unprofessional conduct and conduct contrary to the public interest in violation of NAC 639.7425(2), NAC 639.744, NAC 639.7445, NAC 639.945(1)(i) and (j), and is subject to discipline pursuant to NRS 639.210(4), and (12), and/or NRS 639.255.
- 8. Respondent Oliver, as the owner/operator of Glimpse is responsible for the acts or omissions of its employees/personnel pursuant to NAC 639.945(2), and is therefore subject to discipline pursuant to NRS 639.210(4), and (12) and/or NRS 639.255.

ORDER

THEREFORE, BASED UPON THE FINDINGS OF FACTS, AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW, THE BOARD HEREBY ORDERS:

- Respondent Oliver's Certificates of Registration Nos. PD00349, PD15479,
 CS20010, and CS15479 are disciplined as follows:
 - a. This Order shall serve as a public reprimand regarding Respondent Oliver's duties and responsibilities as a registered dispensing practitioner and controlled substances registrant.
 - Respondent Oliver shall pay fines of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) by cashier's check or certified check or money order made payable to "State of Nevada, Office of the Treasurer," to be received by the Board's Reno office located at 985
 Damonte Ranch Parkway Suite 206, Reno, Nevada 89521, within thirty (30) days of entry of this Order.
 - c. Respondent Oliver shall pay attorney's fees and investigative costs of one thousand three hundred and thirty-one dollars and fifty cents (\$1,331.50) by cashier's check or certified check or money order made payable to "Nevada State Board of Pharmacy," to be received by the Board's Reno office located at 985 Damonte Ranch Parkway Suite 206, Reno, Nevada 89521, within thirty (30) days of entry of this Order.
- 2. Any failure by Respondent to comply with the terms of this Order may result in issuance by the Executive Secretary of an order to show cause pursuant to NAC 639.965 directing Respondent to appear before the Board at the next scheduled Board meeting for hearing. If the show cause hearing results in a finding of a violation of this Order by any Respondent, then the Board may impose additional discipline upon any Respondent consistent with NRS Chapter 639.

3. This Order is effective immediately.
