NEVADA STATE BOARD OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS

COMPLAINT

The Investigative Committee¹ (IC) of the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners (Board), by and through its counsel, Alexander J. Hinman, Deputy General Counsel and attorney for the IC, having a reasonable basis to believe that Joseph Patrick Eafrate, PA-C (Respondent) violated the provisions of Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) Chapter 630 and Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) Chapter 630 (collectively, the Medical Practice Act), hereby issues its Complaint, stating the IC's charges and allegations as follows:

- 1. Respondent was at all times relative to this Complaint a physician assistant holding an active license to practice medicine in the State of Nevada (License No. 482). Respondent was originally licensed by the Board on July 25, 1995.
- 2. Patient A² was a fifty-two (52) year-old male at the time of the events at issue and had multiple medical problems including Diabetes Mellitus Type 2, Hypertension, morbid obesity, GERD, elevated triglycerides, decreased vitamin D level, increased liver function tests, fatty liver disease and right ear pain.

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The Investigative Committee of the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners, at the time this formal Complaint was authorized for filing, was composed of Board members Mr. M. Neil Duxbury, Aury Nagy, M.D., and Michael C. Edwards, M.D., FACS.

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- On or about October 27, 2017, Patient A presented to Respondent at the Forte 3. Family Practice office (hereinafter, the "Practice"), and was diagnosed with otitis media in his right ear.
- Patient A had been an existing patient of the Practice and had informed the Practice 4. that he was allergic to Penicillin on multiple occasions, which was recorded multiple times in his medical records maintained by the Practice.
- On the October 27, 2017, visit, Respondent prescribed Patient A oral Amoxicillin 5. for treatment of otitis media. Patient A filled this prescription at a pharmacy and took the Amoxicillin as prescribed by Respondent.
- Within thirty (30) minutes of taking the prescribed Amoxicillin, Patient A began 6. experiencing shortness of breath, and presented to North Vista Hospital. There, he was diagnosed Hospital staff administered with anaphylactic shock, angioedema, and respiratory failure. IM epinephrine, Solu-medrol, Pepcid, and Benadryl.
- Patient A was then admitted to the ICU at North Vista Hospital, and subsequently 7. was diagnosed with diabetic ketoacidosis ("DKA"). Patient A was hospitalized for three (3) days.

COUNT I

NRS 630.301(4) - Malpractice

- 8. All of the allegations contained in the above paragraphs are hereby incorporated by reference as though fully set forth herein.
- NRS 630.301(4) provides that malpractice of a physician assistant is grounds for 9. initiating disciplinary action against a licensee.
- NAC 630.040 defines malpractice as "the failure of a physician, in treating a 10. patient, to use the reasonable care, skill, or knowledge ordinarily used under similar circumstances."
- As demonstrated by, but not limited to, the above-outlined facts, Respondent failed 11. to use the reasonable care, skill or knowledge ordinarily used under similar circumstances when rendering medical services to Patient A when he prescribed Amoxicillin, despite Patient A's documented allergy to Penicillin.

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By reason of the foregoing, Respondent is subject to discipline by the Board as 12. provided in NRS 630.352.

WHEREFORE, the Investigative Committee prays:

- That the Board give Respondent notice of the charges herein against him and give 1. him notice that he may file an answer to the Complaint herein as set forth in NRS 630.339(2) within twenty (20) days of service of the Complaint;
- That the Board set a time and place for a formal hearing after holding an Early 2. Case Conference pursuant to NRS 630.339(3);
- That the Board determine what sanctions to impose if it determines there has been 3. a violation or violations of the Medical Practice Act committed by Respondent;
- That the Board award fees and costs for the investigation and prosecution of this 4. case as outlined in NRS 622.400;
- 5. That the Board make, issue and serve on Respondent its findings of fact, conclusions of law and order, in writing, that includes the sanctions imposed; and
- That the Board take such other and further action as may be just and proper in these 6. premises.
