NEVADA STATE BOARD OF EXAMINERS

ORDER MODIFYING TERMS OF THE BOARD'S FIND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW, AND ORDER FILED ON OCTOBER 2, 2023

George Peter Chambers, Jr., M.D. (Respondent), License No. 10476, and his counsel, Liborius I. Agwara, Esq., personally appeared in Las Vegas, Nevada, before the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners (Board) at its regularly scheduled meeting on September 13, 2024, requesting modification of the terms of the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order in this case, filed on October 2, 2023 (FFCL Order). Information presented to the Board in connection with Respondent's request is attached hereto as **Exhibit 1**.

After considering the request, the Board enters the following Order modifying the terms of the FFCL Order:

- Respondent currently owes the Board fifty-one thousand seven hundred seventeen 1. dollars and thirty-seven cents (\$51,717.37) in costs and six thousand dollars (\$6,000) in fines pursuant to the FFCL Order.
- 2. Respondent's request to modify the FFCL Order to allow additional time to make payments is hereby **GRANTED**.
- The FFCL Order is modified to allow Respondent to pay the total amount owed in 3. twenty-four (24) monthly payments starting on October 15, 2024, by way of an initial payment of two thousand four hundred and four dollars and ninety cents (\$2,404.90) due on or before October 15, 2024, and then twenty-three (23) equal payments of two thousand four hundred and

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four dollars and eighty-nine cents (\$2,404.89) due on or before the fifteenth day of each month thereafter, with the final payment due on or before September 15, 2026.

- 4. Respondent's request that the Board deem his satisfactory completion of the Professional Boundaries Program through PACE at the University of San Diego in December 2022 as fulfilling the FFLC Order requirement that he complete that program, *see* page 6, section 1(b), is hereby **GRANTED**.
- 5. Respondent further requested that the requirement that he be accompanied by a medical chaperone during the entirety of all patient interactions be lifted. That request is **DENIED**. Accordingly, Respondent must continue to ensure that he is accompanied by a medical chaperone during the entirety of all patient interactions as outlined in more detail in the FFLC Order section 2(a), pages 6 through 7.
- 6. The remainder of the terms contained in the FFLC Order shall remain in effect and Respondent must comply with these terms as stated.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED.

24	1. That I am a licensed physician in the State of Nevada, having been	
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26	issued a medical license in 2003.	
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- 2. That on or about September 15, 2023, the Board voted to revoke my medical license, stayed the revocation, and placed me on probation for two years, along with other requirements, some of which are as follows:
 - Pay the costs of the proceeding in the amount of \$54,217.37 by March 15, 2024.
 - Pay fines in the amount of \$6,000 by March 15, 2024.
 - Complete CPEP PROBE Ethics & Boundaries Course by March 15, 2024.
 - Complete the Professional Boundaries Program through PACE by March 15, 2024.
- 3. That I completed the Professional Boundaries Program through PACE on December 12, 2022, a few months after the Board filed a formal complaint against me, but prior to the Board's orders; that I am requesting that the Board accept the course I took as meeting the requirement in the Board's order for me to take the same course.
- 4. That on or about July 24, 2024, the Investigative Committee ("IC") of this Board suspended my license for failure to timely comply with the Board's orders as outlined above; that this failure, for which I take full responsibility, was due to several factors beyond my control, including (1) inability to secure employment as a result of board-imposed restrictions; and (2) a contentious and expensive divorce from my wife.
- 5. That I am requesting that the Board reinstate my license, so that I can work to take care of my children and pay off the costs and fines imposed by the Board; that it is for this purpose that I make this affidavit; that to show good faith, I

Desert Inn Rd., Ste. 270 Las Vegas, NV 89121 702-385-4800 Phone borrowed some money to make a payment of \$2,500 to the Board toward the costs of proceeding and fines; that if my license is reinstated, I will make monthly payments to the Board until the balance is paid off; that I also have no plans to resume my cosmetic vaginal rejuvenation practice, as all the complaints I have had, including those that led to this case, emanated from this practice area; that I plan to concentrate on obstetrics and gynecology; that I am, as a result, requesting that the Board remove the requirement for me to be chaperoned, as that is already the requirement in all hospitals and the standard of practice, which I have observed in the 25 years of my practice; that having the chaperone as a disciplinary sanction will prevent me from regaining my hospital privileges and board certification, both of which I need to secure meaningful employment.
