Dr. Li was present with his legal counsel, Lyn E. Beggs, Esq.

Dr. Muro asked Dr. Li whether he wanted his application to be considered in closed session, with the public being excluded, and he said that he did.


Dr. Frey moved that the Board go into closed session pursuant to NRS 241.030. Dr. Nagy seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Upon returning to open session, Dr. Nagy moved that the Board grant Dr. Li a conditional license subject to the requirements that both preceptors provide bi-monthly reports, with 100% chart review for the first six months, 50% chart review for the following six months, and 25% chart review for the following six months, and that every six months Dr. Li provide to the Board an evaluation by a neurologist documenting his fit health, with the first evaluation as soon as possible. Dr. Spirtos seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

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10 **ORDER GRANTING LICENSE WITH CONDITIONS**

11 Shouping Li, M.D. (Dr. Li), appeared before the Nevada State Board of Medical
12 Examiners (Board) in Reno, Nevada, at its regularly scheduled meeting on September 16, 2022,
13 regarding his application for licensure as a medical doctor in the State of Nevada. Dr. Li was
14 present and represented by his counsel Lyn E. Beggs, Esq. Board members Victor M.
15 Muro, M.D., President, Aury Nag, M.D., Vice President, Ms. Maggie Arias-Petrel, Secretary-
16 Treasurer, Bret W. Frey, M.D., Chowdhury H. Ahsan, M.D., Ph.D., FACC, Ms. Pamela J. Beal,
17 Col. Eric D. Wade, USAF, (Ret.), Nicola (Nick) M. Spirtos, M.D., F.A.C.O.G., and
18 Carl N. Williams, Jr., M.D., FACS were present. After considering Dr. Li's application, the Board
19 enters the following Order:

20 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the Board grants Dr. Li's application for license subject
21 to the conditions that he comply with a preceptorship plan as follows:

- 22 1. Dr. Charles Stringham shall be the primary preceptor. The primary preceptorship
23 shall be eighteen (18) months and will take place at Dr. Stringham's private family practice
24 located at 50 E. Haskell Street, #A, Winnemucca, NV 89445.
- 25 2. Dr. Stringham will directly observe Dr. Li's patient encounters during the first
26 month of the preceptorship.
- 27 3. Dr. Li will see patients for primary/family care services Tuesday through Friday,
28 every other week, for the first six (6) months of the preceptorship.

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1 4. Dr. Stringham will provide a report to the Board two (2) times per month regarding
2 Dr. Li's provision of patient care. Additionally, Dr. Stringham will advise the Board of any
3 concerns related to Dr. Li's mental health and cognition.

4 5. After the first month of the preceptorship, if Dr. Stringham will be out of the office
5 during anytime that Dr. Li is seeing patients, Dr. Stringham will be available for consultation to
6 Dr. Li by telephone.

7 6. Dr. Stringham and Dr. Li shall discuss clinical care at least two (2) times per month
8 for the first six (6) months of the preceptorship, and as frequently as Dr. Stringham deems
9 appropriate thereafter.

10 7. Dr. Christopher Vlasek, a board-certified family practice physician with Carson
11 Tahoe Medical Group, shall be the secondary preceptor.

12 8. During the first six (6) months of the preceptorship, Dr. Li will observe
13 Dr. Vlasek's patient care for two (2) to three (3) days per week.

14 9. Dr. Vlasek will provide a report to the Board two (2) times per month regarding his
15 review of Dr. Li's patient charts and Dr. Li's program of observation.

16 10. Dr. Stringham and Dr. Vlasek shall between the two of them (divided as agreed
17 upon between them) review Dr. Li's charts on the following schedule:

- 18 a. 100% of Dr. Li's charts during the first six months of the preceptorship;
19 b. 50% of Dr. Li's charts during months 7-12 of the preceptorship; and
20 c. 25% of Dr. Li's charts during months 13-18 of the preceptorship.

21 **IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED** that every six (6) months, Dr. Li shall provide
22 to the Board an evaluation by a neurologist documenting his fitness to practice medicine, with the
23 first evaluation to be completed as soon as possible.

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IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that if Dr. Li does not comply with these requirements, then this conduct may be grounds for disciplinary action and/or immediate suspension of his license pursuant to NRS 630.3065(2)(a) and/or NRS 630.326.
