4. Review and Discussion of Proposed Statutory Changes to Pursue in the 2027 Legislative Session (for possible action)  
*The Subcommittee will review, discuss, and possibly approve a list of proposed statutory changes prepared by Staff with regard to: licensure and regulation of practitioners of respiratory care; genetic counselors; physician assistants; perfusionists; anesthesiologist assistants; adjudication of disciplinary matters in NRS 630.352; virtual meetings; website requirements; denial of hospital privileges; registration of medspa; model medspa legislation; nutrition CME requirements and updating other CME requirements; the respiratory care licensure compact; the physician assistant licensure compact; and revisions to NRS Chapter 644A with regard to oversight of physicians and physician assistants providing advanced esthetic services to patients in their offices.*
5. Review and Discussion of Proposed Regulation Changes Regarding Physician Assistant Supervision and Scope of Practice (for possible action)  
*The Subcommittee will review, discuss, and possibly approve a draft of proposed regulation changes regarding physician assistant supervision and scope of practice.*
6. Review and Discussion of Licensure of Perfusionists Pursuant to Executive Orders 2023-003 and 2023-004 (for possible action)  
*The Subcommittee will review and discuss the Board's responses to the Governor's Executive Orders 2023-003 and 2023-004. Approximately 18 states license perfusionists, and the Subcommittee may vote to recommend to the full Board that licensure of perfusionists be repealed and to pursue that in the 2027 Legislative Session.*
7. Other Statutory Changes Needed (discussion only)  
*The Subcommittee members will list possible statutory changes that may be needed in NRS Chapter 630 or related chapters for Board staff to research. Before any action or recommendation may be made to the full Board, these potential changes will be brought back to a future Subcommittee meeting for further discussion and possible action.*
