4. Review and Discussion of Licensure of Perfusionists Pursuant to Executive Orders 2023-003 and 2023-004 (for possible action)

The Advisory Committee will review and discuss the Board's responses to the Governor's Executive Orders 2023-003 and 2023-004. Approximately 18 states license perfusionists, and the Advisory Committee will discuss recommendations that it would like to make to the full Board regarding the licensure of perfusionists. This may involve deciding whether to draft a letter or other document to provide to the Board at the June 5 Board meeting and/or authorizing one or more members of the Advisory Committee to attend the Board meeting and provide a presentation to the Board on behalf of the Advisory Committee.

5. Other Perfusionist Issues to Discuss at a Future Meeting (discussion only)

The Advisory Committee members will list possible issues, including statutory or regulation changes that may be necessary for the practice of perfusion in Nevada or list possible issues that should be discussed and presented to the Board for possible action. Before any action or recommendation may be made to the full Board, these potential changes will be specifically noticed on a future Advisory Committee meeting agenda for further discussion and possible action.
